

Bankshot in Rockville! Debuts in King Farm Rockville Dept. of Recreation

The City of Rockville, Maryland is proud to announce the grand opening of a Bankshot Playcourt with a tournament at its King Farm Mattie Stepanek Park.

Bankshot is a Total-Mix sport which takes the power-play and violence out of ball playing sports and replaces them with intelligence, pre-figuration, a subtle touch and creative thinking. Bankshot engages the mind of everyone who takes on the challenge of the sport. Bankshot Bank boards have been displayed in two international museums as SportSculptures and in the Discovery Science Museum as applied physics. Bankshot is currently on permanent exhibition at the Boston Children's Museum.

Bankshot Sports are designed as Total-Mix systems based on Universal Design and they are intended for the entire family to play together. They are non-aggressive versions of classic sports. Players of all ages and abilities including wheelchair participants proceed through a course of angled, uniquely configured, brightly colored Bankboards, banking balls through the hoops.
