SCRANTON, PENNSYLVANIA WILL HOST BANKSHOTTM BASKETBALL NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Players from across North America will compete for the 1996 Bankshot title.

(Scranton, PA) Scranton has been chosen to host the annual Bankshot Basketball National tournament on Saturday, August 10, 1996 beginning at 11 AM. The tournament is sponsored by the National Association of Bankshot Operators (NABO). Pepsi and several others.
